Abstract

D7.2 -2nd annual report on grants given in Task 7.1

During the second year of CONCERT the programme of awarding travel grants to students and young scientists continued with small changes, benefiting from the experience of the first year.

Each of the 4 calls was fully subscribed.

D7.2 - 2nd annual report on grants given in Task 7.1

During the period June 1st 2016 – May 31st 2017 applications for travel awards could be submitted four times: 2016 06 30, 2016 09 30, 2016 12 31 and 2017 03 31.

All applications were reviewed by the members of the Education and Training Committee (ETC). Not all applications were eligible, as some were applying to support travel to events, which took place before the application deadline. These applications received 0 points.

Following the first round of applications, concerns were expressed about funding applicants from the same organisation as well as same country. It was decided not to support two candidates from one institution to favour the support of several organisations as well as more actively encourage high-quality applications from many institutions. This decision had some impact in the selection of awardees in the round 2017 03 31.
